That is why the foundation matters more than the emergency response.

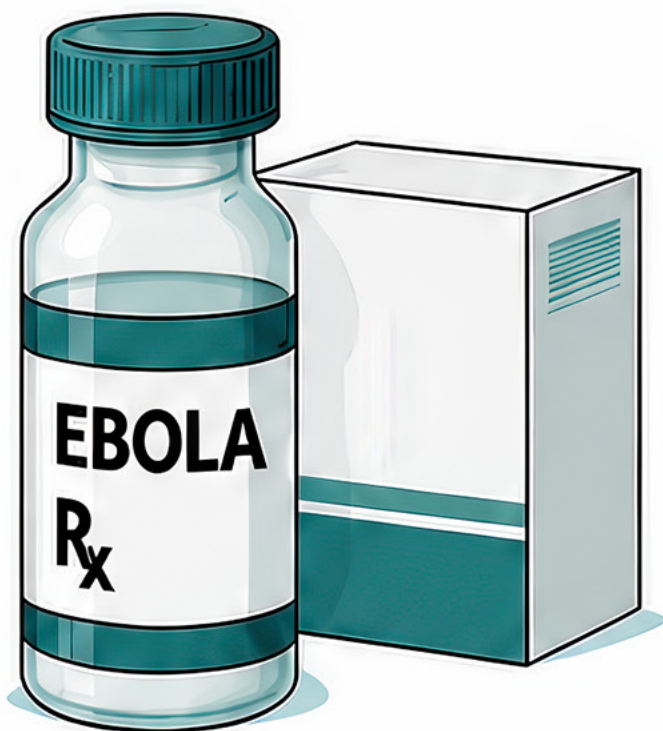


**MYTH**

**MYTH**

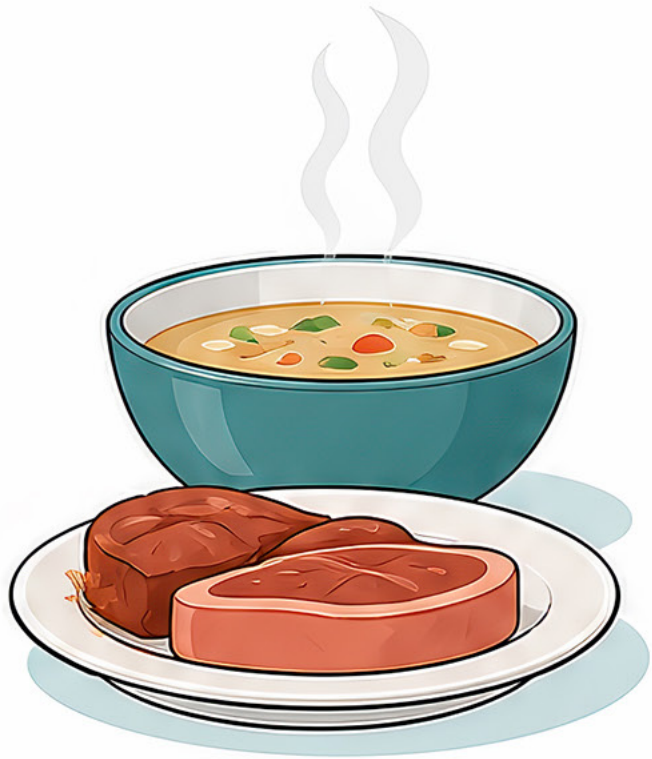
There is no treatment for Ebola.

FDA-approved treatments now exist. Early diagnosis and treatment significantly improve outcomes.



Knowledge is one of the strongest tools in outbreak prevention.

**✗ MYTH**

Ebola can be transmitted through food or water.

**✓ FACT**

Ebola is not spread by food or water. It spreads through direct contact with infected bodily fluids.

**✗ MYTH**

Only sick people can spread Ebola.

**✓ FACT**

A person can only spread Ebola when symptoms appear. People who have recovered cannot spread the virus.
